External Piles are a Bit Different and Will Have Different Piles Symptoms

The actual external ones are usually below the skin located around the anus. They can lose blood and itch when they become irritated. In some cases, blood can swimming pool in these hemorrhoids, which may cause a clot. If a clot happens, severe swelling, inflammation and also pain may happen as piles symptoms.

- Sometimes, an excessive amount of straining can result in the hemorrhoid being pushed out there with the anal opening.
- When this occurs, it is known as a prolapsed or protruding hemorrhoid and it may cause some irritation and pain.
